LETTUCE

Baby Lettuces (arugula, spinach, etc.) are all plentiful and beautiful. Romaine hearts and iceberg are still slightly active due to lower supply volumes.

CITRUS

Lemons are steady with South America to start. New crop clementines from Uruguay and pink-hued grapefruit from California.

PEPPERS

Local green pepper market is great. Red peppers are readily available. Yellow and orange are still active, 11# only.

GARLIC & GINGER
